MARYDEL, Delaware - December 28, 2009 – After a stringent evaluation process, the Berlin Fire Company in Worcester County, Maryland has selected Rosenbauer and Spartan Motors to manufacture their new tanker. The mammoth 4,500-gallon tanker will play a critical role in the water supply during incidents and will replace Berlin's current tanker which is 29-years old.

The Spartan Gladiator LTD chassis will be powered by a Cummins ISM 500 horsepower motor and feature a transverse storage compartment in the rear. A Whelen LED warning light package will be installed including a pair of Freedom FNMINI lightbars on the 10" raised cab roof. In the hosebed area will be a 4,500-watt Command Light light tower. In addition, a Harrison 10kW hydraulic generator will power multiple quartz lights that will be located throughout the apparatus.

The 3/16" aluminum body will be built at Rosenbauer's manufacturing facility in Lyons, South Dakota. The body design will incorporate low-height, 26" deep compartments on both sides and feature wheelwell storage for 12 SCBA bottles. A Zico electric folding tank lift and ladder lift will be mounted above the left and right sides respectively. Multiple shelves will be located throughout the exterior compartments. Each will be lined with Turtle Tile along with the compartment floors.

Three 10" quick dumps will be located on the apparatus with one on each side between the tandem axles and one inside the rear compartment along with a Hannay electrical reel. A pair of 3" direct tank fills will be located on the rear along with a 4" fill on the right side. The pump will be a Waterous CSU 1500 GPM single-stage model.

The truck was sold by Keith Twilley.
