MARYDEL, Delaware - January 13, 2010 – The Nanjemoy Volunteer Fire Department in southern Charles County, Maryland has ordered a new heavy-duty brush truck from Rosenbauer. The platform for the unit will be a Ford F-750 4x4 chassis that will be provided by the fire department.

A custom-fabricated, extreme-duty brush guard will be mounted on the front bumper which will be extended 20" ahead of the cab. The bumper will be made from steel channel and painted red to match the cab and body. Also located on the bumper will be a 15,000-pound Ramsey electric winch and Federal Q2B electro-mechanical siren.

Providing fire suppression will be a Hale AP pump rated at 500 GPM and monitored by a FRC InControl TGA400 pressure governor. The pump features stainless steel intake and discharge manifolds. There will be (2) 4" intakes, (1) 2-1/2" intake, and (1) 2-1/2" direct tank fill. Discharges include (2) 1-3/4" crosslays, and a pair of 2-1/2" discharges, (1) on each side. An Odin Mongoose CAFS system powered by a Kawasaki gas engine and Darley 2BE pump will supply (2) Hannay hose reels each with 200' of 3/4" hose.

The heavy-duty extruded aluminum body will house a 400-gallon water tank and 30-gallon foam tank. A rear storage compartment will measure 60" wide x 26" high x 26" deep and be enclosed by a roll-up door. Atop each rear fender will be a hosewell that will carry 200' of hose. An 80" long tool storage compartment will be located in the center of the hosebed.

Scene lighting will be provided by (5) FRC Focus 150-watt HID, 12-volt quartz lights including (1) brow light, (2) telescoping at the front of the body, and (2) recessed in upper body sides. A combination of Weldon and Whelen LED warning lights will be located throughout the apparatus. All ground, step, and compartment lights will also be LED. The unit will also feature a Powercall electronic siren.
