MARYDEL, Delaware – January 22, 2010 – An order for a new Rosenbauer rescue pumper has been placed by the Violetville Volunteer Fire Department. Violetville is the second volunteer department in Baltimore County to order a Rosenbauer in the past month. The Spartan chassis will have a 194” wheelbase and feature a Gladiator EMFD cab with a 10” raised roof.

A Hale QMAX 1500 GPM single-stage pump will be supplied by a 750 gallon water tank and feed 8 discharges, including two in the front bumper. The pump will be monitored by a Fire Research InControl TGA400 pressure governor. The main hosebed will be feature diamondplate hosebed covers with electric actuators to raise and lower the covers independently.

The 3/16” formed aluminum body will offer full-height compartments with hinged doors, upper coffin compartments on both sides, and internal storage for the ground ladders, hard suction hose, and backboards. The body compartments will be sprayed with spatter paint for durability and be illuminated by T-Lite LED compartment lights.

A Harrison 8kW hydraulic generator will be used to power multiple Fire Research and Havis quartz lights. This includes a pair of brow lights, upper body lights, and two on the rear of the body. Other features include a Firecom 3010R vehicle intercom system, Whelen LED warning light package, including an LED Traffic Advisor and water tank level lights mounted on the side of the cab. Of course no Violetville apparatus would be complete without a pair of Mars 888 lights, bell, and a Roto-Ray.

The truck was sold by Ron Willett.
